DEPUTIES HUNT FOR FUGITIVE, FIND DRUGS IN AKRON

On Wednesday, Nov 30th, Deputies with the Hale County Sheriff's Office were notified a possible fugitive from Tuscaloosa County was hiding out in the Akron area. The Sheriff's Office notified the U.S Marshal assigned to the case as well as the Tuscaloosa County Sheriff's Office. The units executed a felony warrant on Oak Village Road in Akron around 6pm. Michael Antwon Noland, of Tuscaloosa was taken into custody for two outstanding warrants in Tuscaloosa County. Mr. Noland was charged with Attempted Murder, and Discharging a Firearm Into an Occupied Dwelling. While deputies were executing the warrant, they located approximately one pound of marijuana, forty six grams of cocaine, and \$2,842.00 in cash money. Lorenzo Benson of Akron was also arrested and charged with; Unlawful Possession of Marijuana 1st Degree, Trafficking Cocaine, and Unlawful Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Noland is being held in the Tuscaloosa County Jail without bond and Benson is being held in the Hale County Jail under \$921,000.00 bond.
