GREENSBORO – The Sheriff's Office can confirm it has received complaints involving alleged animal cruelty of cattle on AL. Hwy 69, just north of Greensboro. The Sheriff's Office is assisting the U.S.D.A as well as state agriculture investigators. We also can confirm the owner of the cattle has been under the supervision of the Payne Animal Clinic and is following the protocol established by the clinic. The Sheriff's Office is also actively investigating an open case from September of this year where the owner of the cattle filed a report in which some of the cattle were shot and/or poisoned. That case is still under investigation. No further information will be released at this time as these are both open investigations.
