SHERIFF'S OFFICE REDESIGNS PATROL CAR FLEET

The Hale County Sheriff's Office recently upgraded and redesigned its patrol car fleet. Sheriff Kenneth W. Ellis announced he is fulfilling his promise to the voters of Hale County after the recent Special Amendment Election. "I told the voters if they voted for Amendment #1 in August that I would only spend that money to upgrade equipment and operate the Hale County Jail, I am keeping my promise". The Sheriff's Office purchased four 2011 Ford Crown Victoria Police Cars to update the older, high mileage patrol cars that were in use. The Sheriff said, "Ford Motor Company stopped producing the Crown Victoria back in February, but Chief Deputy McCrory found 300 of them in Georgia. He ordered four and had them here within a few days. The Chief redesigned the graphics on the patrol cars to reflect a more modern look, as well as installing laptop computers and video camera systems. We have gotten a lot of compliments on the cars, and I am proud to have them patrolling the highways neighborhoods of Hale County."
